Burning Hearts

Luke 24:32

They asked each other, “Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?”

I once had someone say to me: “So, you’re following the law now. Well, I think we should put our focus on reaching the lost for Jesus.”

I thought that was kind of interesting because since I’ve come to start growing in the whole truth; I’ve never been more alive and excited in my faith, resulting in me wanting to share even more.

In fact, Luke 24:32 means more to me now than ever before. I can honestly say that I had that experience of everything just clicking all at once. Like a light bulb truly popping on in my heart and making my heart just burn with joy and excitement.

Anyone who has come to the understanding of the whole word still being alive knows what I’m talking about.

Think about this for a moment. How many get excited about reading the Old Testament? Normally people today mainly just read the New Testament because they say the Old Testament is boring or just doesn’t make any sense.

And yet these two individuals found in Luke 24:32 had a personal Bible study with the savior as they walked along the road; a bible study that consisted ONLY of the Old Testament. And their hearts were on fire because of it. It all came together. And it all made sense. They were connecting the dots like never before.

And when the Lord opens the scriptures of the Old Testament for you like He did for the two on the road to Emmaus, your heart will burn with a zeal just the same.

For that’s when you see all the dots truly connecting. You’ll see how the feast days are STILL a shadow of the things to come. How the fall feast days represent His return and thereafter just as the spring feast days represent His first coming - to the day.

You'll see how the parable of the prodigal son is all about the lost tribes of Israel; the Northern Kingdom who never came back unlike the Southern Kingdom.

So many things will come to life in the Scriptures when you see just how they're all related together.

How can we truly imagine that we can understand the back of the book without grasping the front of it? Just like with a teacher, he starts his students at the beginning of a textbook instead of jumping to the last half. Doesn't it make sense that we should do the same with the Scriptures?

Doesn't it only make sense that we'll never truly understand the back of the book until we begin grasping and understanding of the front of the book?

I encourage you today to ask the Father to open the Scriptures for you like He did for those on the road to Emmaus. When He does, your heart will burn like never before as you see the whole Word of God come alive.
