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The First Five Trumpets

This teaching is in response to questions we have received regarding our thoughts of how the end times may play out, with special emphasis to the first five trumpets of Revelation.

In the first edition of this teaching, we briefly covered the topic of knowing the day and hour of Yeshua’s next coming. We covered this in response to many e-mails that we had received. We now cover this topic in detail in our teaching titled “The Pre-Tribulation Rapture.”

That being the case, we will not be covering it in this new edition of this teaching. Yet, we still want to cover the topic of the new temple. There are many who say that a temple HAS to be set up for the Antichrist. But there is little to base that on. Though, we believe that there very well could be a temple established for the end times, we see little to *prove* that it HAS to be.

Many like to use Revelation 11 for this. It’s where John is told to go and measure the temple. Compare:

Revelation 11:1-2

I was given a reed like a measuring rod and was told, “Go and measure the temple of God and the altar, and count the worshipers there. But exclude the outer court; do not measure it, because it has been given to the Gentiles. They will trample on the holy city for 42 months.”

There are several things that don't add up with using these verses as support for suggesting that there HAS to be a temple for the end times to begin. One is simply that the whole city is given over to the Gentiles yet the inner courts of the temple are not. Physically speaking, and that’s what we’re talking about here, a physical temple, how can this make sense?

Historically, anytime the city of Jerusalem was physically taken over, the temple was too. All of it. If a physical temple IS made and the inner courts are divinely protected, how will this make the Antichrist look, not being able to enter his “own” temple?

Plus, there actually seems to be a Scriptural contradiction to this claim of the “need” for a temple. Here in Revelation it says the outer courts are given over to the Gentiles but the inside has the alter and the worshipers.

While at the same time 2 Thessalonians 2:4 says the Antichrist sets himself up IN God's temple claiming to be God.

2 Thessalonians 2:4

He will oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or is worshiped, so that he sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God.

How can he claim to be God if he is only allowed in the outer courts of his own temple?

Revelation 11 says that the outer courts will be "given over to the Gentiles" and only the worshipers of God are in the inner courts.

"Given over to the Gentiles." Let us not forget that "Gentile" means "of the nations," meaning, not of THE nation of God, Israel. So, according to Revelation 11, one who is not of THE nation of God, the body of Christ, is not allowed in the inner courts. So if the Temple here is to be taken as a literal physical temple, how can the Antichrist himself be allowed in, since he is obviously not of the body of Yeshua?

Again, we are not saying that there won't be a temple established for the end times. We are simply saying that we don't see enough evidence to prove that there HAS to be one, especially using Revelation 11 for support or proof text.

We are open to any further discussion on this topic. But we currently don't see any Scriptural evidence that would prove the necessity for a temple to be in existence for the appearance of the Antichrist.

And now, regarding the first five trumpets of Revelation:

What you are about to hear is simply our thoughts of what we see as POSSIBLE fulfillment's of the first five trumpets as given in Revelation. This sequence of events could play out on any given year. However, we *do* believe it is very plausible for it all to begin close after a Feast of Tabernacles, which is also called Sukkot.

Some have said that Moses approached Pharaoh just before Sukkot. That this was the feast Moses approached Pharaoh for the Israelites to go out and celebrate. Yet, obviously this was not the feast God knew they would be celebrating in the exodus.

It is believed that God could have talked to Moses through the burning bush on the day of Trumpets. Then Moses approached Pharaoh 10 days later on the Day of Atonement. Yet Pharaoh not only refused to let the Hebrews go, he increased the work load of the Hebrews while keeping the work quotas the same. Thus, just as they were about to enter Sukkot, where we are commanded to rejoice, they are given more reason to be sad and mourn.

It is possible that the plagues actually began not many days after that the Hebrews celebrated Sukkot. Though this is all just a theory and truly can't be proven, it seems to us that the Judgments would have started after the days of the feast, giving the Hebrews the feast to overcome their challenge to rejoice in the face of their new trial.

If all of this is indeed the case, it means the plagues could have lasted close to 6 months 'til Passover,

the 15th day of the first month.

There is really no way to know exactly when the plagues started. And we agree that it's very easy to read it all as a sequential order that happened within weeks up to Passover.

Some have suggested that everything could have started around the twenty-fourth day of the ninth month, the time of Hanukkah. If this is indeed the case, it would mean the plagues only lasted approximately three months. We agree that this does indeed seem interesting for several reasons. We find this is the same amount of time that Moses was hidden when he was a child.

Exodus 2:2

And she became pregnant and gave birth to a son. When she saw that he was a fine child, she hid him for three months.

And this date has an interesting appearance in the prophets.

Haggai 2:18-22

From this day on, from this twenty-fourth day of the ninth month, give careful thought to the day when the foundation of the LORD's temple was laid. Give careful thought: Is there yet any seed left in the barn? Until now, the vine and the fig tree, the pomegranate and the olive tree have not borne fruit. From this day on, I will bless you. The word of the LORD came to Haggai a second time on the twenty-fourth day of the month: "Tell Zerubbabel governor of Judah that I will shake the heavens and the earth. I will overturn royal thrones and shatter the power of the foreign kingdoms. I will overthrow chariots and their drivers; horses and their riders will fall, each by the sword of his brother.

Why the importance of noting the day here? Twice even, verse 18 AND 20. Is this to identify importance to this date? Possibly even showing when this prophecy that is given will take place? Hard to say. We know that history is cyclical.

Ecclesiastes 1:9

What has been will be again, what has been done will be done again; there is nothing new under the sun.

And

Isaiah 46:10

I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say: My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.

This verse in Haggai is regarding the future. If the end is made known from the beginning, could this verse about the future be identifying something that happened in the past just as much as what will be happening in the future?

We don't know. It's interesting. But again, it's all theory.

So possibly, starting sometime between Sukkot and Passover, everything can begin by way of the birth pains. Just as Egypt was destroyed and Israel protected in the plagues, we will also be in the birth pains as well. I'm talking total devastation, all leading up to us being divinely protected in the wilderness

during the time of the Antichrist.

And just as the Israelites traveled to 42 cities during the wilderness, we will be protected during the 42 months of the Antichrist rule.

We do not claim these as absolutes in any way. Please understand that. We are human. We are simply giving our current thoughts to what we see as having a very plausible fulfillment in these days we are living in.

As always, do not take our word for anything but test EVERYTHING. And, if anything, hopefully our thoughts can trigger thoughts for you as well. We are all students.

Having said that, let's begin.

Isaiah 24:1

Behold, (Yahweh) the LORD lays the earth waste, devastates it, distorts its surface, and scatters its inhabitants.

Regarding the inhabitants, verse 17:

Isaiah 24:17-20

Terror and pit and snare confront you, O inhabitant of the earth. Then it will be that he who flees the report of disaster will fall into the pit, and he who climbs out of the pit will be caught in the snare; for the windows above are opened, and the foundations of the earth shake. The earth is broken asunder, the earth is split through, the earth is shaken violently. The earth reels to and fro like a drunkard, and it totters like a shack, for its transgression is heavy upon it, and it will fall, never to rise again.

Here we see that which would resemble a massive, in fact, a global shaking of the earth.

And for the longest of times, these verses were taken to be symbolic. However, a literal interpretation could very well be more than plausible. It could very well be an event like this which truly jumps the birth pains into high gear, an event that causes earthquakes around the globe or in diverse places if you will.

Compare their similarity to those verses in Haggai chapter 2 that we read earlier concerning the prophecy given on the twenty-fourth day of the ninth month.

Haggai 2:21-22

“Tell Zerubbabel governor of Judah that I will shake the heavens and the earth. I will overturn royal thrones and shatter the power of the foreign kingdoms. I will overthrow chariots and their drivers; horses and their riders will fall, each by the sword of his brother.

Could these be the birth pains that set up the latter half of the confirmation of the new covenant?

With this in mind, we will go through the first five trumpets of their order and explain their POTENTIAL fulfillments. Again, it must be noted that we are not declaring any of this to be facts but rather findings that we believe are very plausible, findings that we believe should not be overlooked or quickly dismissed but at least considered and looked at for a moment.

First we must ask ourselves, “Do the actual trumpets that sound in Revelation make these events happen?” Or are they simply proclaiming that which is already coming?

Unlike the Seals and the Bowls of Revelation, we believe the Trumpets *COULD* actually be that of signifiers to that which is going to happen versus that which *makes* those events happen.

So are we saying that the trumpets will be audible for us to hear these warnings? No. Not necessarily. Though we suppose that could be possible, at least for true believers to hear. We simply believe that the trumpets mentioned in Revelation are warnings of that which is to occur.

We believe that these may be *natural* events pertaining to the birth pains that are to come, as mentioned in Matthew 24 and not so much “judgments from the throne” if you will, but rather natural judgments that come about on a land because of disobedience.

Thus the trumpets are the warning signals for His people during this time.

Let’s begin, but let’s begin just a few verse before the beginning of the Trumpets. A few verses that we believe is all too often overlooked.

Revelation 8:3-6

Another angel, who had a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense to offer, with the prayers of all the saints, on the golden altar before the throne. The smoke of the incense, together with the prayers of the saints, went up before God from the angel’s hand. Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and hurled it on the earth; and there came peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning and an earthquake. Then the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to sound them.

Here we see an action given with a result on the earth, a result that ended in an earthquake. This is the Greek word used here for earthquake *seismo/β* – *seismos*, also rendered as a “shake down.”

Is it possible that this shake down may very well be what *causes* the following sequence of events with the given warnings of the trumpets?

First, the shake down, the cause, that which makes the foundation of the earth to shake. Again, like what we see in Isaiah 24:

Isaiah 24:18-20

For the windows above are opened, and the foundations of the earth shake. The earth is broken asunder, the earth is split through, the earth is shaken violently. The earth reels to and fro like a drunkard, and it totters like a shack, for its transgression is heavy upon it, and it will fall, never to rise again.

Yet here we see the details explained in the verses that follow the opening.

Trumpet #1

Revelation 8:7

The first angel sounded his trumpet, and there came hail and fire mixed with blood, and it was

hurled down upon the earth. A third of the earth was burned up, a third of the trees were burned up, and all the green grass was burned up.

Most have believed this to be asteroids falling from the sky, and that is possible. Yet the text doesn't say where the source of the hail and fire mixed with blood comes from. It simply says that it was hurled down upon the earth.

If I gathered a bunch of rocks from the ground, could I not, then, hurl them back down on ground by initially throwing them straight up? Of course. That which goes up comes back down.

So what if the source of this hail, fire and blood was all the active and potential active volcanoes on Earth?

Think about it. Hail and fire by themselves can easily be understood for an asteroid. But where would the "blood" be? However, take a volcano, and you can easily understand how it can look like hail, fire and "blood" by way of the magma.

Is it not possible that the Earth crust could force magma up and out, giving the very appearance of hail, fire and blood mixed together? Could an earthquake that rocks the whole planet cause such an event? Time will only tell, but we believe that this is very plausible, one that should not be quickly dismissed.

This scenario may be difficult to imagine since we've never seen something of that magnitude before, but scientists have already declared that when the caldera under Yellowstone National Park goes off that it will explode with a force 1000 times more powerful than the eruption of Mt. St. Helens back in 1980. 1000 times more powerful. (See <http://www.earth-issues.com/tag/yellowstone-national-park/>).

That ONE volcano has potential to be 1000 times more powerful than Mt. St. Helens. That in itself is hard to imagine. Yet if most every volcano on earth is thrust into activity at the same time, the devastation could truly be unimaginable.

Yet, could there really be a shaking that would affect that many fault lines on the earth which would in turn affect that many volcanoes? Well, here are some thoughts to consider.

Did you know that the Ring of Fire has 452 volcanoes? Four hundred fifty-two. It is home to over 75% of the world's active and dormant volcanoes. So three-fourth's of all active and dormant volcanoes sit on the ring of fire. It is sometimes called the circum-Pacific belt or the circum-Pacific seismic belt. And even the Pacific Rim (see <http://geography.about.com/cs/earthquakes/a/ringoffire.htm>).

About 90% of the world's earthquakes and 81% of the world's largest earthquakes occur along the Ring of Fire. Allow me to repeat that.

About 90% of the world's earthquakes and 81% of the world's largest earthquakes occur along the Ring of Fire (see <http://earthquake.usgs.gov/learn/glossary/?termID=150> and http://commons.bcit.ca/civil/students/earthquakes/unit1_01.htm).

So, as you can see, this scenario is more than plausible in just the first trumpet alone. Let's continue.

Trumpet #2

Revelation 8:8-9

The second angel sounded his trumpet, and something like a huge mountain, all ablaze, was thrown into the sea. A third of the sea turned into blood, a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

Apocalyptic language has shown a mountain to represent that of a nation or country. We already know that the earthquake that Japan had in March of 2011, literally shifted Japan 8 inches.

So, if a 9.0 earthquake shifted it by 8 inches, what kind of earthquake would it take to make the island of Japan go under water? May sound silly at first, but let's not forget that Japan physically sits on the Ring of Fire. Could Japan be that huge mountain that is thrust into the sea?

Could this same earthquake that thrust all the volcanoes into action along the ring of fire actually cause Japan to go under? Only time will tell.

Knowing that an isolated 9.0 earthquake caused it to shift 8 inches, is it really that unthinkable to consider that a mega quake that shakes the whole earth could submerge it? This would obviously cause a tsunami of unbelievable proportions. That would explain the one third of the ships being destroyed. And **IF** it would be Japan, that could explain the waters turning to blood by way of their nuclear reactors that have plutonium that is said to be 1000 times more lethal than that of Chernobyl. Again, the plausibility is well within the spectrum of reality.

Trumpet #3

Revelation 8:10-11

The third angel sounded his trumpet, and a great star, blazing like a torch, fell from the sky on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water — the name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters turned bitter, and many people died from the waters that had become bitter.

Many have believed this to be an asteroid, and we agree that is very possible. But the problem is that we never see the impact of this star in the verse. Yet, we know it affects a third of the rivers and a third of the springs of water. But "How?" is the question.

As we will see in the 5th trumpet, a star shown in the blowing of the trumpets of Revelation can actually be a fallen angel. We'll cover that in more detail in a moment. Yet in this case, as with the 5th trumpet, we believe this star to be that of a fallen angel. Could this fallen angel somehow worsen the effects of the first two trumpets on water sources?

In the light of natural events, this trumpet could very easily be caused from the remaining effects that simply compounds from the first two trumpets. It says that the waters become bitter. Think of it for a moment. Between the toxic ash of the volcanoes and the radiation from the nuclear plants in Japan that will be working its way around the globe, do we really think that water supplies are not going to be effected? And remember, the trumpets are declaring what's coming. They are not making them come. The fact that we hold to this star being a fallen angel will make more sense when we cover the 5th trumpet.

Before we move on, it's interesting to note a parallel here. Again, notice how the waters become bitter and how many die from the waters. What about those who don't die from the bitter waters?

Numbers chapter 5:11-28 talks about the woman who is accused of adultery. It discusses the process of

finding out if she is guilty. It just so happens that the process includes her drinking bitter water.

Some have even suggested that this parallels also that of when Moses came down from getting the stone tablets and found many of the people dancing around the golden calf. What did Moses do? He ground up the golden calf and put it in the water for the people to drink.

It is suggested that those who were killed that day were identified as the adulterers because they were sick from that which they drank. Meaning that the water with the gold in it made them ill and those who didn't dance around the calf were not affected by the water. Those who were made sick from the water were then struck down.

Could it be in the end times that the Father gives those of His people, who are accused of adultery, bitter waters to drink as prescribed in Numbers 5? Then those who are found guilty will be stoned in the final bowl of wrath as mentioned in Revelation 16?

Revelation 16:21

From the sky huge hailstones of about a hundred pounds each fell upon men. And they cursed God on account of the plague of hail, because the plague was so terrible.

This is truly a stunning parallel and one that we believe should not be overlooked.

So could it be possible that the first bowl identifies those who are guilty?

Revelation 16:2

The first angel went and poured out his bowl on the land, and ugly and painful sores broke out on the people who had the mark of the beast and worshiped his image.

Then it all concludes with the stoning at the last bowl? Only time will tell.

Moving on...

Trumpet #4

Revelation 8:12

The fourth angel sounded his trumpet, and a third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them turned dark. A third of the day was without light, and also a third of the night.

Notice here how on the 4th trumpet a third of the sun, moon and stars are turned dark just like that of the 1st trumpet where a third of the earth, trees and grass were burned up.

After volcanoes erupt, ash clouds can cover multiple square miles within hours before settling. Just like the Iceland volcano did in April of 2010. It sent ash, smoke and steam miles into the air as seen here. Covering many square miles.

Now imagine if 452 volcanoes erupt together within a 12 to 24 hour window. It says that a third of the sun, moon and stars turn dark. Interestingly enough, as you can see, it appears the Ring of Fire covers just over one-third of the planet.

It doesn't take much imagination to see that this could easily be caused by the first 3 trumpets. So we see the first 4 trumpets could easily be simultaneously back to back events that are actually tied to one massive event within a 12 to 24 hour period.

But we see the remaining trumpets are set apart from these first 4. Compare...

Revelation 8:13

As I watched, I heard an eagle that was flying in midair call out in a loud voice: "Woe! Woe! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the trumpet blasts about to be sounded by the other three angels!"

Trumpet #5

Revelation 9:1-2

The fifth angel sounded his trumpet, and I saw a star that had fallen from the sky to the earth. The star was given the key to the shaft of the Abyss. When he opened the Abyss, smoke rose from it like the smoke from a gigantic furnace. The sun and sky were darkened by the smoke from the Abyss.

We'll continue with this text in a moment, but first look at how the star that fell was given a key and then opened the abyss. Does that sound more like a fallen star or asteroid? Or does it sound like a fallen angel?

This is why we see the star in the 3rd trumpet to also be that of a fallen angel.

Continuing on with the verse...

Revelation 9:3-11

And out of the smoke locusts came down upon the earth and were given power like that of scorpions of the earth. They were told not to harm the grass of the earth or any plant or tree, but only those people who did not have the seal of God on their foreheads. They were not given power to kill them, but only to torture them for five months. And the agony they suffered was like that of the sting of a scorpion when it strikes a man.

During those days men will seek death, but will not find it; they will long to die, but death will elude them. The locusts looked like horses prepared for battle. On their heads they wore something like crowns of gold, and their faces resembled human faces. Their hair was like women's hair, and their teeth were like lions' teeth. They had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the sound of their wings was like the thundering of many horses and chariots rushing into battle. They had tails and stings like scorpions, and in their tails they had power to torment people for five months. They had as king over them the angel of the Abyss, whose name in Hebrew is Abaddon, and in Greek, Apollyon.

What you are about to hear may sound utterly absurd and we agree, it kinda does. However, if you were told that the Red Sea was going to be divided in front of you, we're sure you would have said "That sounds absurd."

With this in mind, we don't ask that you just believe us. We ask that you keep it as something to be considered.

There has been a lot of silence from prophecy teachers on these verses of the 5th trumpet. So now, we'd like to give you something that we believe seems to make perfect sense as a **POSSIBLE** interpretation to these verses. We know that the Scriptures say that history repeats itself.

Ecclesiastes 1:9

What has been will be again, what has been done will be done again; there is nothing new under the sun.

In order to give an understanding to this possible interpretation, allow us to read from 2 Thessalonians.

2 Thessalonians 2:9-12

The coming of the lawless one will be in accordance with the work of Satan displayed in all kinds of counterfeit miracles, signs and wonders, and in every sort of evil that deceives those who are perishing. They perish because they **refused to love the truth** and so be saved. For *this reason* God sends them a **powerful delusion** so that they will believe the lie and so that all will be condemned who have not believed the truth but have delighted in wickedness.

Yahweh Himself sends a powerful delusion as mentioned here that seems to come **BEFORE** the lawless one and his counterfeit miracles, signs and wonders and the evil that he deceives with. It is because of **THIS** powerful delusion that those who refuse to love the truth will be deceived by the workings of the lawless one.

It must be noted here that the true test of a prophet or miracle worker is if they follow and teach Torah - the commandments of Yahweh. Even if his prophecies come true and his miracles take place before your very eyes, if he teaches others to follow anything other than the commandments of Yahweh, he is declared a false prophet. Compare:

Deuteronomy 13:1-4

If a prophet, or one who foretells by dreams, appears among you and announces to you a miraculous sign or wonder, and if the sign or wonder of which he has spoken takes place, and he says, "Let us follow other gods" (gods you have not known) "and let us worship them," you must not listen to the words of that prophet or dreamer. (Yahweh) The LORD your God is testing you to find out whether you love him with all your heart and with all your soul. It is (Yahweh) the LORD your God you must follow, and him you must revere. Keep his commands and obey him; serve him and hold fast to him.

Please see our teaching titled "The Deuteronomy 13 Test" for more details on this.

Regarding 2 Thessalonians, what form of powerful delusion could make people turn from Yahweh and follow after a lie? What kind of event could happen that would convince people to follow the Antichrist and his miracles?

What if fallen angels made themselves manifest by way of ... aliens? As strange as that may sound, what if? We already know that the Scriptures **indicate** that the fallen angels mated with women in the Old Testament as given in Genesis 6:2, 4. Yet not much is given to us in how they revealed themselves in those days. What if they manifested themselves as a higher life form from another planet? Is that really so hard to believe? Maybe for some, but knowing that the Scriptures mention this has happened once before. Are we to believe it can't happen again?

Remember:

Ecclesiastes 1:9

What has been will be again, what has been done will be done again; there is nothing new under the sun.

Knowing that *there are* indeed ancient accounts giving record of this in previous civilizations and how the Scriptures give record to it in harmony with the other accounts, why should any of us be surprised at this being at least a possible fulfillment to the 5th trumpet in Revelation 9?

Again, let's not forget:

Isaiah 46:10

I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say: My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.

That definitely gives reason to believe that there may be more to what Yeshua said in Matthew 24:37.

Matthew 24:37

As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.

We know this verse on the surface is alluding to how everyone was just living their lives not knowing the judgment was coming. Yet, could this one sentence be alluding to something else as well? Could it be that in the days of the return Christ (at the end) that the ways of the Nephilim will have returned by way of the fallen angels all over again as mentioned in the book of Genesis? Revealing themselves as aliens?

There are those who oppose this belief as being something plausible. And we respect that. But in our research and in looking at the teachings of others, we have not seen enough evidence to say that this should be ruled out as something as plausible.

In reference to making known the end from the beginning, it's interesting to note that the locusts of the 5th trumpet are given power for 5 months. 5 X 30 days, making 150 days. Now compare in the days of Noah:

Genesis 7:24

The waters flooded the earth for a hundred and fifty days.

Are these dots that we should be connecting together? We're not sure. But it's interesting nonetheless. Time will tell.

There are some who even refer to the aliens as the "Anunnaki". They believe these were the ones who were in Mesopotamia and that they are returning to, once again, enslave much of mankind. Interestingly enough, the Anunnaki may very well have been those mentioned in Numbers 13 when Moses sent the spies into the land. Compare:

Numbers 13:22

They went up through the Negev and came to Hebron, where Ahiman, Sheshai and Talmi, the

descendants of **Anak**, lived. (Hebron had been built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.)

The phrase "the descendants of Anak" in the Hebrew actually says "the descendants (born) of **the** Anakim."

A little farther down:

Numbers 13:28

But the people who live there are powerful, and the cities are fortified and very large. We even saw descendants of Anak there.

Again, "**the** Anakim"

Farther down still:

Numbers 13:31-33

But the men who had gone up with him said, "We can't attack those people; they are stronger than we are." And they spread among the Israelites a bad report about the land they had explored. They said, "The land we explored devours those living in it. All the people we saw there are of great size. We saw the Nephilim there (the descendants of **Anak** come from the Nephilim). We seemed like grasshoppers in our own eyes, and we looked the same to them."

Again, "**the** Anakim"

The Biblical accounts of the recordings of the Anakim could very easily be those noted as the Anunnakki from the Mesopotamian records. Both give accounts to them being very large individuals and both accounts are dated to being thousands of years old.

We believe it's quite possible that...

Ecclesiastes 1:9

What has been will be again, what has been done will be done again; there is nothing new under the sun.

This may very well be the powerful delusion that the Lord sends so that people will believe the lie of the Antichrist as mentioned in 2 Thessalonians chapter 2.

If an event of this nature and magnitude happened in the midst of the birth pains (that of the large earthquakes), imagine what would be going through the minds of the survivors of the first 4 trumpets, of those who were not true believers and especially those who do not even claim to be followers of Yeshua at all.

The devastation from the shaking of the earth alone would make many say "How could God let such a horrible thing like this happen?"

Then, IF, and we say "IF", aliens (or fallen angels) would appear in the guise of the origins of the Anunnaki, the very existence of God would not only be questioned, it would be mocked upon by the huge majority of the remaining populace, especially in light of all the sun god prophecies that will at that moment "have come true". Thus making other civilizations' prophecies true and so making those of the

Scriptures seem meaningless. Especially since the “prophecy” of the dearly held pre-trib rapture, that so many believed and heard of, had failed.

This would not only create a huge disregard for God and His Word, it would generate an intense hate for anyone who tried keeping their faith in Him. This ties in line with what Yeshua says right after He first mentions the beginning of the birth pains in Matthew 24:8.

Matthew 24:7-13

For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places. All these are but the beginning of the birth pains. THEN you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of me. At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other, and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people. Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.

The key word here in verse nine is "Then" indicating it takes place right after the wars and revolutions, famines and earthquakes have taken place, or at least just after they have truly started.

IF, and we say “IF” aliens are what the locusts are referring to at the 5th trumpet in Revelation 9, then these verses that explain that which happens after the beginning of the birth pains makes all the more sense. Believers will truly be hated for holding to the name of Christ, from a Biblical perspective anyway, in light of what will be transpiring before the whole world. Quite possibly like Noah may have been mocked for building the ark.

We realize that all of this is a lot to take in. And like all others who voice their thoughts on these verses, we do not claim that our thoughts are without error. We simply hope that they help us all to open our hearts to the Spirit and not hold on to interpretations just because “That’s what we’ve always believed.”

Compare the following verses:

Jeremiah 4:19-21

The **sound of the trumpet**, the alarm of war. **Disaster on disaster is proclaimed**, How long must I see the standard and **hear the sound of the trumpet?**

Could this be the first 4 Trumpets of Revelation sounding back to back?

Jeremiah 4:22-24

“For My people are foolish, they know Me not; they are stupid children And have no understanding. They are shrewd to do evil, but to do good they do not know.” I looked on the earth, and behold, it was **formless and void; and to the heavens, and they had no light**. I looked on the **mountains, and behold, they were quaking, and all the hills moved to and fro**.

Could these verses soon find themselves coming to a literal fulfillment? Time will only tell.

We pray that you begin your own research on this matter and determine what actions, **if any**, you need to do to prepare. We believe that Yahweh does nothing without first revealing to His servants what He is going to do.

Amos 3:7

Surely the Sovereign (Yahweh) LORD does nothing without revealing his plan to his servants the prophets.

So we pray that all our hearts will be attentive to that which the Father is speaking at this time.

We want to clarify that this is not to scare but rather to prepare. For...

Proverbs 27:12

The prudent see danger and take refuge, the simple keep going and suffer for it.

We know that the Father has been calling His people back to His ways. It is our prayer, here at 119 Ministries, that His people WILL return to His ways. Otherwise, many of His people may eventually say the exact same as those taken in the dispersement of those of Hosea.

Hosea 6:1

“Come, **let us return** to the LORD. He has torn us to pieces but He will heal us; He has injured us but He will bind up our wounds.

Let us not forget the Lord's own words:

Isaiah 46:10

I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say: My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.

We pray you found this teaching to be of use. The Lord be with you all.
